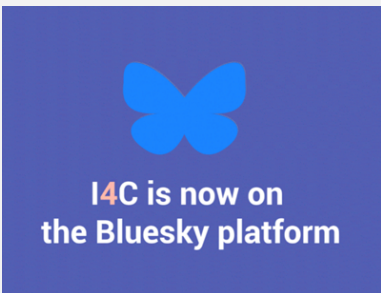
Spotlight on a young researcher: Francine Schevenhoven from the University of Bergen
