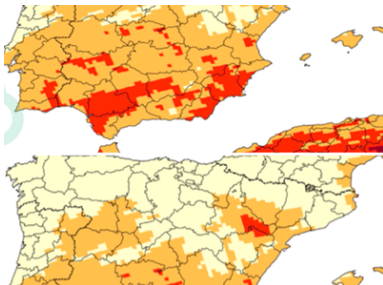
INSIGHTS FROM I4C RESEARCH



When the sun goes down, heat vulnerability remains: evidence from the I4C Barcelona demonstrator

A new study, led by the Barcelona Supercomputing Center and carried out by the Earth System Services group at BSC-CNS, in collaboration with the Universitat Autònoma de Barcelona, highlights how night-time heat is becoming an increasingly serious and unequal climate challenge for urban populations.
